Recycling electronics recovers valuable materials and, as a result, helps reduce greenhouse gas emissions and pollution while saving energy and resources by extracting fewer raw materials from the earth.

In addition, by participating in this event you are helping the non-profit organization Urban Corps achieve its mission of providing green job training and education to at-risk youth.

IMPORTANT: As a general safety precaution, always make sure information in data storage devices, such as computers, smartphones, copiers, etc. is completely removed prior to donation or recycling.

Acceptable Items:

- Computers /Laptops/monitors
- Computer mice/ keyboards
- Computers peripherals
- CD players
- VCR/DVD Players
- Cell phones /phones
- Small home Office Copiers/ Fax Machines
- Printers
- TVs/ Radios/Mp3 players
- Electronic toys and Games
- Photo and Video Cameras

Prohibited Items:

- Hazardous Wastes/ Liquids
- Loose Alkaline Batteries
- Toner Cartridges
- Light Bulbs & Glass
- Fluorescent lamps
- Tires
- Wood Speakers
- Common Electrical Appliances (e.g., washers, dryers, stoves, air conditioner, refrigerators, microwave, ovens, satellite dishes, space heaters, irons, hair dryers, vacuums, power hand tools)
